

About Programme

The DBA Programme is designed specifically for senior, experienced professional managers in the private and public sectors seeking to become a practitioner-researcher in their field. Unlike a traditional Ph.D., the DBA enables candidates to make a contribution to knowledge through the "novel application of theory" rather than the "development of new theory".

The DBA aims to support professionals from a wide range of occupations to enhance skills in order to develop novel solutions to address key challenges facing business today, including corporate social responsibility, globalization, and managing change.

This is a three-year programme which commences with structured coursework designed to build research competencies, followed by a practical oriented research project that applies those competencies to improve business practices or to add new practices. Students acquire advanced knowledge of literature and theory in their field that provides a foundation for their area of specialization. They will be given theoretical and practical knowledge of advanced research skills, which is essential for publishing in leading journals.

Objectives

- ◆ To enhance managerial and professional practice through the application of sound theory and rigorous research into real and complex issues in business and management.
- To develop the capabilities for disseminating new ideas and findings from research to the business, and academic communities, as well as the society in general.
- To develop personal, consultancy and research competencies to undertake rigorous research at an advanced level that contributes to theory and practice in business and management.
