

MAGNATE 2022 – QUIZ COMPETITION

Magnate 2022 quiz competition will consist of two phases. One is the preliminary written test and the other is the final on-stage quiz competition. Preliminary written test is open for all the students of the Faculty of Management and Finance (FMF), University of Colombo. It will be held physically at Faculty premises on 30th September, 2022. Top two teams of the preliminary written test will be qualified for final on-stage competition which will be held on 7th October, 2022.

Preliminary Written Test

- Teams are consisted with three (03) members who can participate for the preliminary test.
- Deadline for the registration is 23rd September, 2022.
- Teams have to fill the Google form given in the below link on or before 23rd September, 2022.

- Further, Teams have to send their information to the both emails listed below on or before 23rd September, 2022. tharinduediriwickrama@dfn.cmb.ac.lk and madhara@dfn.cmb.ac.lk
- Information of the application should cover details below.
 - ✓ Team name
 - ✓ Full names of team members
 - ✓ Registration numbers
 - ✓ Department and the academic year which they represent (If a team member is from 1st year or 2nd year, it is enough to mention the academic year only).
 - ✓ Email addresses
 - ✓ Mobile numbers
- This test is consistent with 30 multiple choice questions. Time allowed is one (01) hour.
- All three members of the team should answer the test together.
- For each correct answer 01 mark will be awarded and no negative marks are given.
- Test will cover questions in relation to areas listed below including both local and foreign contexts.
 - ✓ General Management
 - ✓ Finance and Economics
 - ✓ Local and foreign current affairs
 - ✓ Local and foreign business affairs
 - ✓ General knowledge
 - ✓ Sports and entertainment
- Results of the preliminary written test will be announced on 03rd October 2022.

Final On-Stage Competition

- This consists of three rounds.
- In each round, each member will be asked one question where the total number of questions per round is six.

- Allowed time to answer a question is 30 seconds and 10 marks will be awarded for the correct answer.
- If a team member gives a wrong answer, same question will be passed to the opposite team. If they give the correct answer, 5 marks will be awarded. Time allowed is 15 seconds.
- Team members are not allowed to discuss before giving the answer. No negative marks are given for wrong answers.
- Questions for each round will cover areas below.
 - ✓ 1st round – Finance, Economics and Management
 - ✓ 2nd round – Current and business affairs
 - ✓ 3rd round – General knowledge, sports and entertainment
